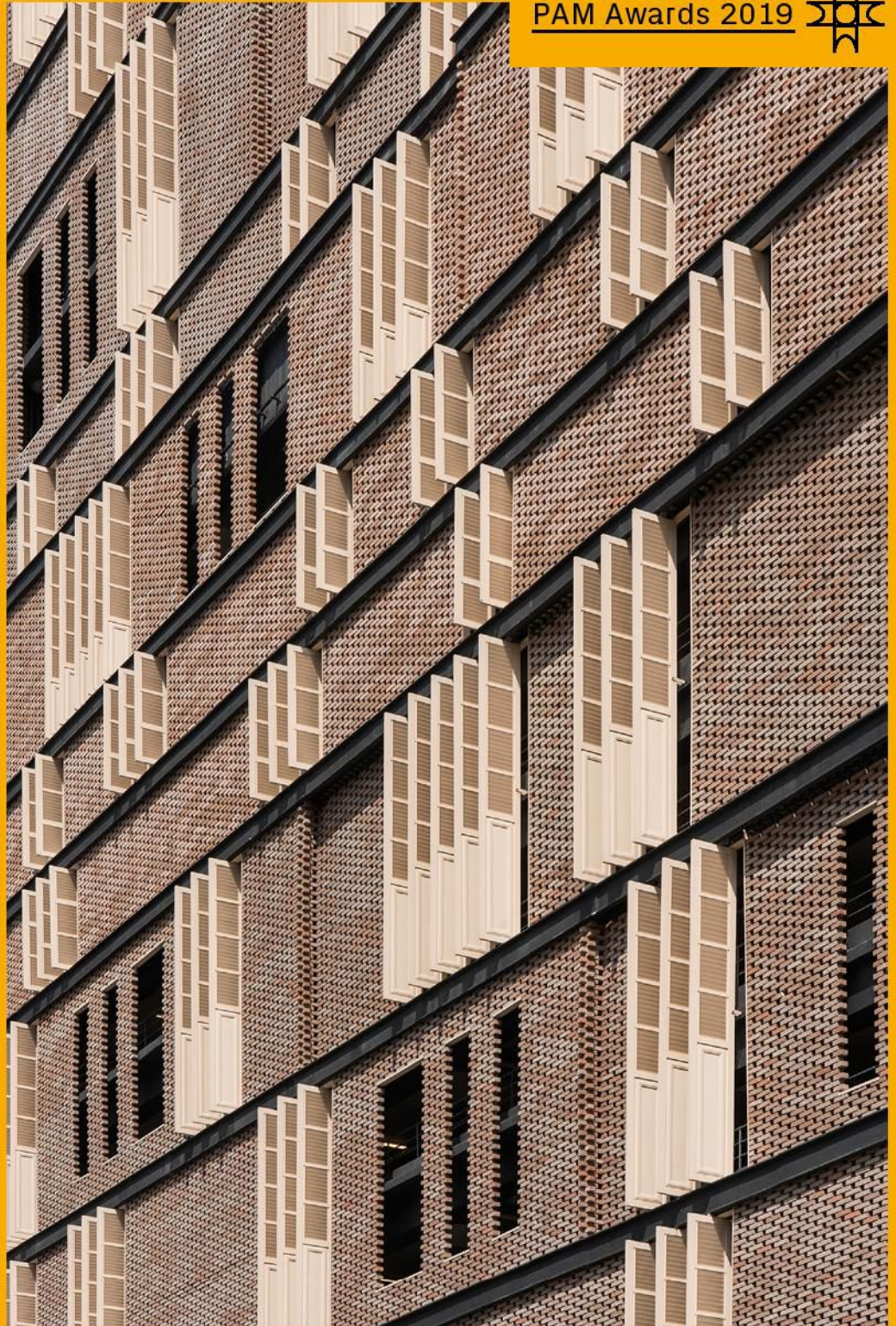

Canopy House

Being up on the hills of Ukay Heights with its jungle-like setting, the design priority is to preserve the natural surroundings of existing huge rain trees and to take advantage of the cool breeze that permeates within. In order to preserve the existing slope, the structure appears to perch on its ground and almost levitates above it. The big shady trees and its canopy give birth to the idea of a large canopy in which all habitable spaces huddle under its protection, shielding the interiors from the heat whilst still capturing the breeze and views through carefully arranged apertures and openings.

Skan House

Skan House is home to a family unit of parents and two grown-up adult children, all having separate time and schedules requiring separate personal spaces. While the house is capable of accommodating the private living spaces, the common living space come first, then allowing the family to bond together as one. Open spaces and lush landscaping permeated skies and mortgages that make up for the lack of garden areas within the site as the design balances the idea of liberating the needs and functions of the individual apart at the shared domestic or more collective. The house is literally the hanging gardens of Babylon with breathable air permeating and work allowing for naturally ventilated spaces without the need for any artificial mechanical cooling.
